APA Format: Basic Rules You Must Follow

Align the text of an APA Style paper to the left margin. Leave the right margin uneven, or "ragged." Do not use full justification for student papers or manuscripts being submitted for publication. Do not insert hyphens (manual breaks) in words at the end of line.

Long story short, do not italicize an APA citation for web pages' title in the text and on the final page of references. For full references on the final page of the project, only include capital letters at the beginning of the title, at the beginning of each proper noun, and at the beginning of the first word in the subtitle.

APA formatting is used for writing papers in the sciences and social sciences, while MLA formatting is intended more commonly for papers written in the humanities/liberal arts areas. As for the formatting itself, MLA formatted papers don't have a title page or abstract while APA papers do.
