CHARTING SYSTEMS 1. Narrative Format This is the most familiar method of documenting nursing care. It is a diary or story format in chronological order. It is used to document the patient's status, care, events, treatments, interventions, and patient's response to the interventions.

CHARTING EXAMPLES FOR PHYSICAL ASSESSMENT SKIN, HAIR AND NAILS Skin pink, warm, dry and elastic. No lesions or excoriations noted. Old appendectomy scar right lower abdomen 4 inches long, thin, and white. Sprinkling of freckles noted across cheeks and nose. Hair brown, shoulder length, clean, shiny. Normal distribution of hair on scalp and perineum.

Examples & Functions of Nursing Documentation

General Guidelines Focus charting must be Evident at least once every shift. Focus charting must be patient- oriented not nursing task- oriented. Indicate the date and time of entry on the first column. Separate the topic words from the body of notes: ° Focus note written on the second column. ° Data, Action and Response on the third column.

Focus Charting (FDAR) - SlideShare

Charting that is divided into sections or blocks. Emphasis is placed on specific sections, or sheets of information. It also uses graphics and narrative charting

Always use a chronologic documentation format, providing separate entries for each narrative item. Block charting, or charting that doesn't separate each activity by timed entry, doesn't provide a clear picture of the sequence of events surrounding the care of the patient. Never use medical terminology unless the meaning of the word is known.

The charting by exception method employs flow sheets of all types, references to established standards of nursing care, and a narrative nursing progress note which only includes significant and/or abnormal data and information.
